As a reminder, you and your dependents have access to most of your plan-related information online. You have secure access to the following plan-related information:

- Medical claims processed from January 1, 2014 to present
- Explanations of benefits (EOBs) for medical and dental services
- Deductible, coinsurance and copayment expenses
- Pension credits, accruals and balances
- Vacation balances and transfers to Qualstar Credit Union
- Work histories
- General communications mailed from Carpenters Trusts from January 1, 2014 to present
- Messaging center if you are unable to call Carpenters Trusts during business hours or if you simply don't like talking on the phone

If you haven't previously registered, go to ctww.org to register. Online access is available to you, your spouse and your children age 13 and older. Each individual must register separately with their own email address and password.
